U.S. army trains Nigerian troops on confronting Boko Haram

Some 12 U.S. soldiers have trained Nigerian troops on a six-week advice-and-assist mission in Jaji, Kaduna State, Pentagon has said. The U.S. Department of Defence said Nigerian Army's 26th Infantry Battalion might be the next to deploy to Northeast to confront the violent extremist organisation, Boko Haram.

Troops of 28 Brigade on operation LAFIYA DOLE have killed three members of the Boko Haram sect. They killed the sect members while on clearance patrol, in conjunction with hunters and vigilantes to Jaje, Borno State. The troops also rescued 33 family members of Boko Haram terrorists, comprising 15 women, 6 boys and 12 girls during the operation.
