Fresh attacks leave three injured as cattle rustling

Residents of Ndeiya ward in Limuru have expressed fears of fresh attacks by cattle rustlers. They claim rustlers are now targeting sheep, adding that more than 100 sheep have been stolen. Their concern comes two months after leaders from Kiambu and Kajiado counties met at the Bomas of Kenya and brokered a peace deal to end cattle theft.
