CONSULTANCY SERVICES TO DEVELOP TRAINING MANUAL FOR THE PREVENTION OF VIOLENT EXTREMISM: PROCUREMENT NO. ACSRT/PROC/101.20

The African Centre for the Study and Research on Terrorism (ACSRT) of the African Union and the Human Security Division of the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs (HSD/FDFA) of Switzerland have set up a capacity-building joint framework program for the Prevention of Violent Extremism (PVE) for Member States and Regional Economic Communities of the African Union.
